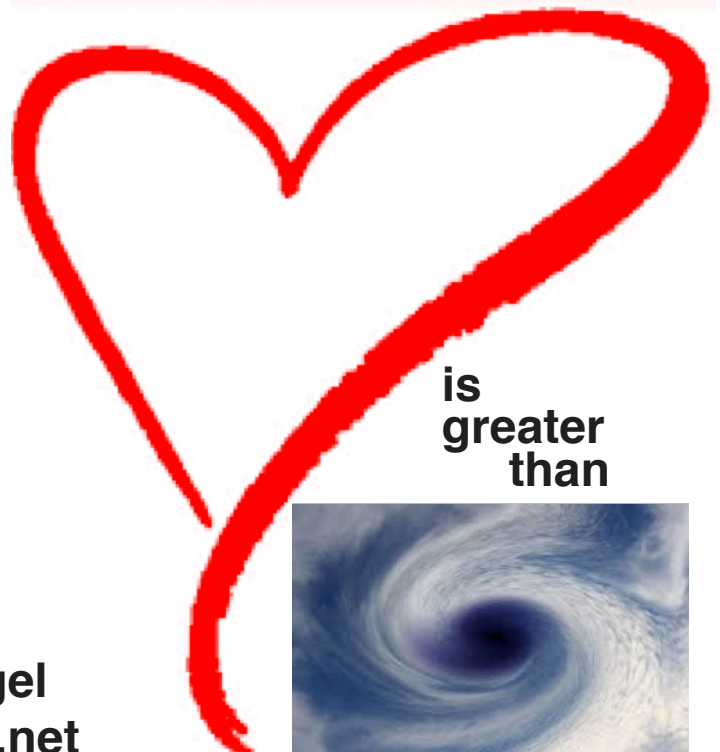
What: Below is the list of items that are in each bucket. Kelly Moore Paint Company has been gracious to provide 100 new Five Gallon buckets that we will fill and seal. In addition to the items on the list, please add an encouraging note sending love from you and/or your family and friends. Buckets will be made available to you, or you may get your own if you wish (please make sure it has a sealable lid). Complete buckets and bulk supplies are totally welcome. Just indicate on the checklist which items you have already included so we can get the rest. We will also be receiving monetary donations to purchase supplies and support the shipping. Please make checks payable to Bethel Lutheran Church, put "Flood Bucket" in the memo, and get them to Tom Hoegel (see contact info below).

When: We are collecting supplies from now until Sunday, October 29th. Tom Hoegel, with Big Dog Sound, will drive away in his truck and trailer that night for Texas to deliver the supplies to the State Multi-Agency Warehouse in San Antonio on November 1st. You can bring completed buckets and/or individual items by Bethel Lutheran Church in Cupertino anytime, plus we will have a special collection, sort and blessing on Sunday, October 29th as a part of iServe Sunday and in worship.

FLOOD BUCKET KIT

- 5 gallon bucket with re-sealable lid
- 2 1-quart or one 82 oz. bottle bleach
- 5 scouring pads
- 1 pack sponges – assorted sizes
- 1 scrub brush
- 18 cleaning towels (reusable wipes)
- 2 - 25 oz. or 1- 50 oz. bottle liquid laundry detergent:
- 1 general purpose household cleaner, 12-16 oz. bttl
- 1 16-28 oz. bottle disinfectant dish soap
- 50 clothes pins
- 2 - 50 ft. or 1 100 ft. clothes line
- 5 dust masks
- 2 pair latex or non-latex gloves
- 1 pair work gloves
- 24-bag roll of heavy-duty trash bags (33-45 gallon--remove roll from box before placing in bucket)
- 1 can insect repellent spray (if aerosol, cans must have protective caps)
