

Note: Forty-two of the 61 online survey responses are from members who did not attend the first Mission Profile event. A summary of the results from 40 attendees of the first event follows. (The number indicates people who agreed it was a strength/weakness, followed by why it was listed as a strength/weakness):

Strengths:

- 1) **Children, Youth and School** – 31 [Youth forums, many and age-appropriate; youth ministry, 3 yrs to 12th grade; children's programs, elementary, confirmation, high school, Common Ground, responsible nursery; school = great staff, spiritual focus, strong academics]
- 2) **Worship** – 28 [Diverse styles; 2 services; variety, outdoor, sunrise; meaningful; communion regularly]
- 3) **Serving the Community** – 21 [Mission to Mexico, San Jose; serving others = quilters, Stephen Ministry, Second Harvest, Family Shelter, Juvenile Hall, Tanzania, Junque sale]
- 4) **Preaching, Teaching, Bible Study** – 17 [existing Bible study groups]
- 5) **Music** – 11 [variety; choirs, variety of style and instruments; Common Ground; pastoral canting]

Weaknesses:

- 1) **Engaging Members** – 25 [Volunteerism for Sunday school and council; limited volunteer participation; getting new people into established groups; finding ministry leads and council members; volunteers for outdoor worship]
- 2) **Welcoming New People** – 21 [invite neighbors; outreach and evangelism; harder for singles, young professionals to gain entrance/support/comfort]
