

Out-n-About San Francisco Brewery Walk

Saturday, March 21st - 11:00 - 5:00



Lace up your walking shoes and Hop on the Bethel bus as we head up to San Francisco for this year's Saint Patty's Brewery tour.

We will meet at the Bethel parking and leave at 11:00 to head to SF for a 2.2 mile brewery-walk along Howard Street and beyond, taking us to 3 breweries.



The Bethel Bus will drop us at our first stop which will be Thirsty Bear, where we will have a group reservation for lunch along with trying their beers. Given we will be a large group, Thirsty Bear policy calls for a \$20 average food and drink spend per person on the final bill.





Leaving Thirsty Bear we will take a 20 minute walk along Howard Street to Cellarmaker Brewing. This brewery has been consistently top rated among SF breweries. Much smaller than our first stop we may be shoulder to shoulder with our fellow walkers, but the brews will be worth it.

From Cellarmaker we walk another 20 minutes along Howard and then onto 14th to Standard Deviant Brewing. This brewery opened in 2016. This is another spot getting good reviews. The brewery is an open space with picnic tables, board games, jenga and shuffleboard for entertainment while you enjoy some of their brews.





As we wrap-up at Standard Deviant, if the weather is good, we will meet the bus over on Valencia Street by taking a 15 minute walk down Mission and then across Clarion Alley where we can view the street art murals painted on the walls along the alley.
